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## Who We Are

Western American Correctional Health Services Association (WACHSA) is a non-profit organization that has been running for 40 years and comprises an all-volunteer board. Board members come from various backgrounds, including jails, prisons, and juvenile halls, and have expertise in medicine, social work, and dentistry. All disciplines are welcome to join the organization. WACHSA is highly collaborative and has partnerships with affiliates across the country.

Our primary goal for 2023 is to improve fundraising through improved communications, increase attendance to our annual event, develop an awards program recognizing excellence in correctional health in the Western States, and continue to provide high-quality correctional conferences covering specialty fields such as correctional medicine, behavioral health, addictions medicine and recovery, dental care, and re-entry into the community.

#### Mission, Vision & Values

WACHSA provides support, skill development, and education programs for personnel, organizations, and decision-makers involved in correctional healthcare, resulting in increased awareness, professionalism, and community for correctional health personnel and promoting positive healthcare and service delivery changes for detained and incarcerated individuals, resulting in healthier communities and lowering healthcare costs for all.

#### **Our History**

WACHSA began as a Chapter of the national organization, the American Correctional Health Services Association (ACHSA). ACHSA was in operation from 1982-2017.

The California-Nevada Chapter was established by Barbara Cotton, RN, with cofounder Bonnie Norman, RN, Chief of Medical Services for the Los Angeles Sheriff's Office in 1982/1983. Bonnie and Barbara were National ACHSA Board members, and they organized California as a State Chapter of ACHSA affiliation with the American Correctional Association (ACA). With the support of the California Medical Association (CMA) and by extension, American Medical Association (AMA) funding.

ACHSA recognized excellence in correctional health care delivery through its annual recognition and award program, the "Distinguished Service Award", based on significant contributions to correctional health care such as developing an education program for staff or inmates, publishing a book or articles on correctional health, conducting research related to correctional health, and/or helping to improve the public image of correctional health care. Additionally, ACHSA did the following:

- Convened national/regional multidisciplinary professional development conferences, which provided continuing education on the latest developments in correctional health care along with opportunities to network with colleagues.
- Assisted in programming on health care issues for other national health organizations upon request.
- Supported six Regional Chapters
- Was an affiliate of the American Jail Association (AJA).
- Had a representative on the Board of Directors of the National Commission on Correctional Health Care (NCCHC)

#### Who We Help

The ultimate benefactors are our patients, inmates living in carceral settings.

Providing prison and jail healthcare is difficult due to costs, stigma, discrimination, transportation, and frequent moves. Inmates have high rates of chronic disease, infectious disease, and mental health and substance use issues. Housing is crowded, with higher rates of infections. Correctional facilities are often poorly staffed & equipped.

WACHSA offers a venue to discuss these issues and strategize on organizational and operational mitigation plans.
